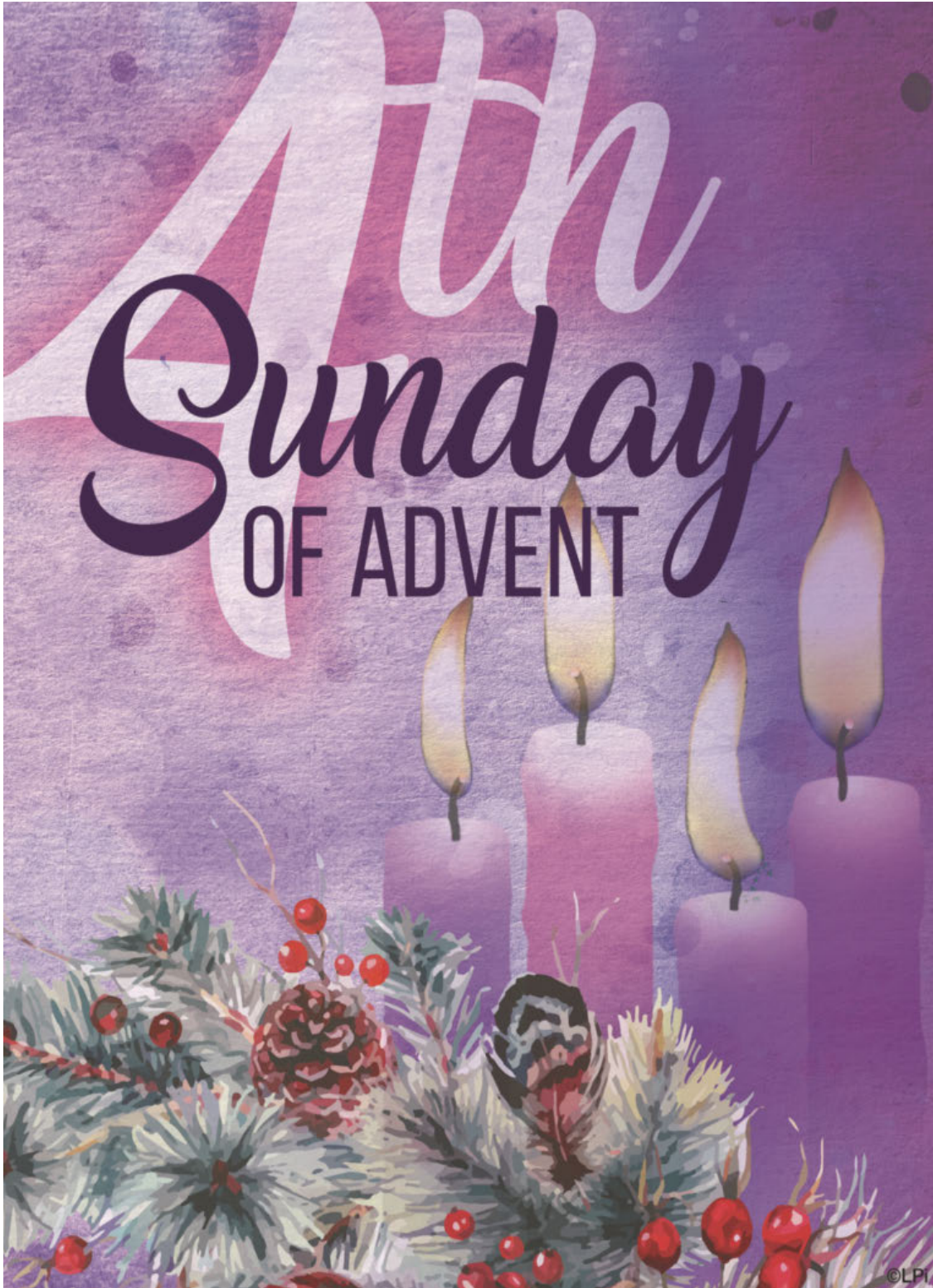

## Update on 2023 Coat Drive for Mission of Our Lady of the Angels

Our coat drive ended the last weekend November. Your response to Sr Stephanie’s request for coat donations to The Mission of Our Lady of the Angels in Humboldt Park Chicago, was again amazing!

December 2 was the handout and the line for coats extended over a city block. Thanks to the generosity of the people of St Alexander many people in that neighborhood now have warm winter coats.

- Our parish was able to provide 26 cases of new winter coats with for total of 312 coats.
- We collected 170 + used coats.
- I would also like to acknowledge these contributors who helped to make the drive so successful:

  - ⇒ A special thanks to those parishioners who donated a total of \$2000 allowing us to buy new coats.

**Faith Formation held a La Posada on Sunday, December 10, 2023.**

### **Introduction and Opening Prayer:**

#### **Gathering: “A Journey with Mary and Joseph”**

At the time of Caesar Augustus, when Quirinius was governor of Syria, a census was ordered. Everyone was required to travel to their own home town to be registered. So Joseph traveled from where he lived in Nazareth to his ancestral home in Bethlehem. His betrothed, Mary, accompanied him on the journey despite the fact that she was pregnant,. Scripture tells us that when they arrived in Bethlehem, they had difficulty finding lodging in the crowded town and finally had to settle for an animals’ stable. It was there that the road-weary parents welcome the birth of their first-born child, and made a bed for him in the hay of the animals’ feeding trough because there were no better accommodations.



The story of Mary and Joseph seeking refuge is a story repeated by refugees, immigrants and exiles in many times and places throughout the world. It is the story of the Sojourner, the Pilgrim, searching for a new land and a new life. It is our story as well. We have all been sojourners of some type at some time in our lives. We have all sought refuge and safety, sustenance and security. Tonight, let us rejoin the journey of the refugee. God into La Posada, the Inn: God’s house of refuge and hospitality. The group of Travelers now walk the path to the first Posada. As they walk, the group can sing verses of a Christmas Carol.

### **Prayer:**

Father in heaven, our hearts desire the warmth of Your love and our minds are searching for the light of Your Word. Increase our longing for Christ our Savior and teach us to understand that in submitting to those over us with joyful obedience, we permit Your loving designs for each of us to be accomplished. Amen.



### **Mexican tradition: Pidiendo Posada**

When reenacting Mary and Joseph’s quest for shelter in Bethlehem, participants in the traditional Posada processions stop to sing a litany at several designated homes. The verses alternate one by one between those seeking lodging outside and those responding from behind the door.

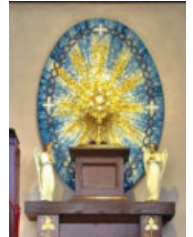



# Navajo Nation

**Information Meeting**  
January 17, 2024

The Diocese of Joliet will return to Navajo Nation for a two-week mission focused on construction and outreach from June 1 to 14, 2024.

The Diocese of Joliet has been putting faith into action—through intentional service and solidarity with the poor—in Chinle, Arizona, for 20 years.

The Office of Mission is seeking parishioners (18+) willing to help local area families with light construction work. No experience is necessary, but a heart willing to serve is required! Missionaries stay on the campus of Our Lady of Fatima, and the trip will include a pilgrimage to New Mexico's Loretto Chapel and its "miraculous staircase."

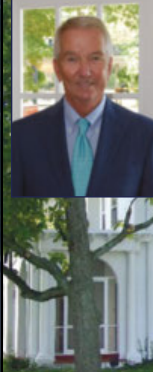
