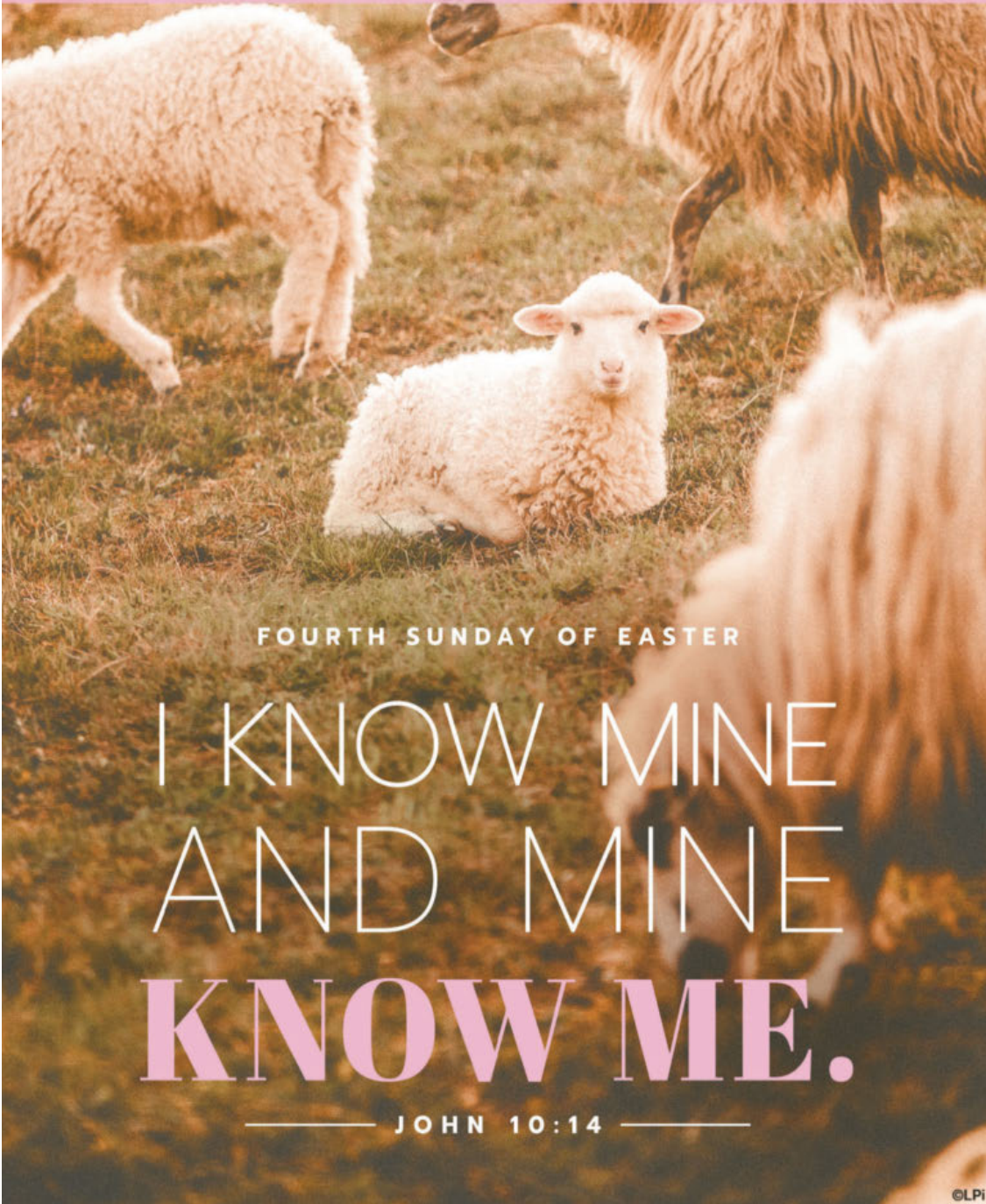

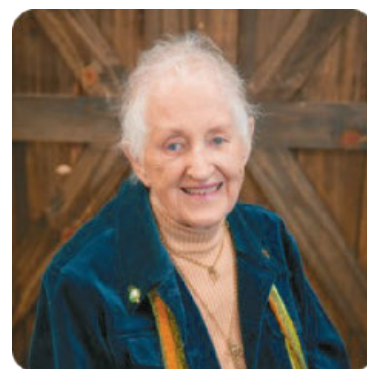
# CONGRATULATIONS: RAE RUPP-SRCH CCW WOMAN OF THE YEAR

The Council of Catholic Women of St. Alexander Parish, Villa Park, IL, is proud to present to you the 2024 Woman of the Year, **Rae Rupp-Srch**.

Rae moved to Villa Park from the South Side of Chicago in 1962. “I had a very challenging and unusual childhood” which led to 7 moves in one year before she attended Chicago’s Visitation High School, thanks to the loving experience and care of her grandparents. That turbulent early childhood led Rae to an affinity for helping others. She ultimately feels blessed by friendships and colleagues.

Rae Rupp-Srch is a very involved Christian woman that has been an active member of St. Alexander Parish since the late 70’s when she and her husband, Richard, transferred from a neighboring parish. At that time, they had noticed that the parishioners of St. Alexander were very involved, and they loved this parish and its people. It made a lasting impression on her that almost every person received the Eucharist when attending mass.

Rae, being the mother of four sons, (one deceased) has been a widow since 2009. Richard, her deceased husband, was one of her extremely enthusiastic supporters. She possesses a long list of civic and humanitarian leadership roles in our community. Here at St. Alexander Church, she is an Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion and works on the 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Committee. Rae has been serving the CCW Board for many years as Community/Legislation Chair, while being active in all of the CCW activities: kitchen at the CCW Craft Fair, Spring Luncheon, Salad Supper, Prayer Blanket Ministry, and Feed My Starving Children. She is also a former Bereavement Minister.

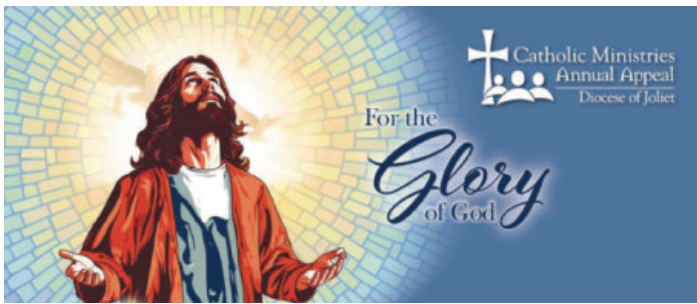
# Parishioner Registration

## Why register with St. Alexander Parish?

**Faith is a Journey, not a Destination.** Registering with the parish is a commitment to your Faith Journey and St. Alexander's would like to walk with you.

### Benefits to registering as a Parishioner:

1. Registration helps you stay connected with the parish, builds community and helps the parish stay connected with you.
2. Other parishes (*including St. Alexander*) often request verification of a person's status as a practicing Catholic, attendance at Mass, sacraments, etc., when that person has been asked to be a **Godparent or Confirmation Sponsor**. Without registration, no such verification can be made.
3. Census numbers may determine how many priests are assigned to a parish and how many Masses and enrichment programs are planned and scheduled.



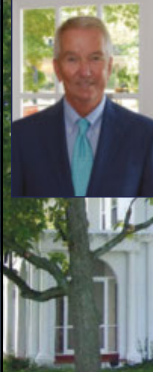
