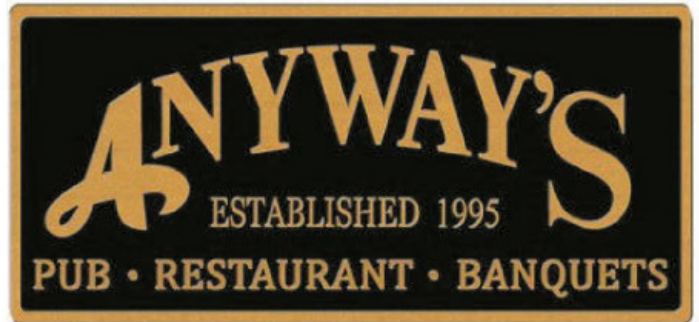

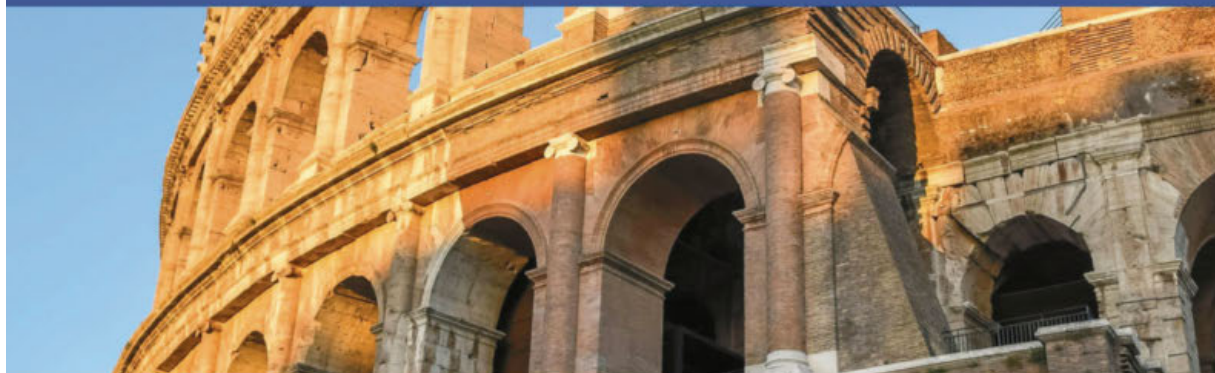
Altar Server Bowling and Pizza Party

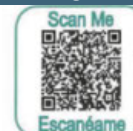

Benefits to registering as a Parishioner:

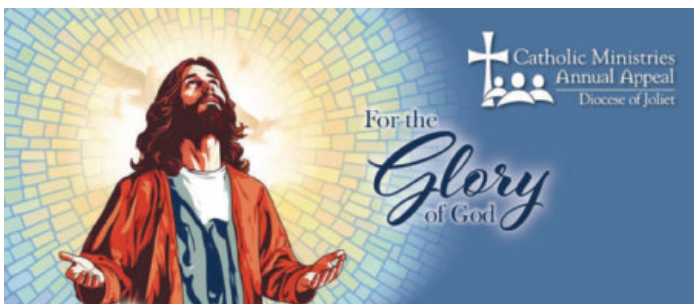
1. Registration helps you stay connected with the parish, builds community and helps the parish stay connected with you.



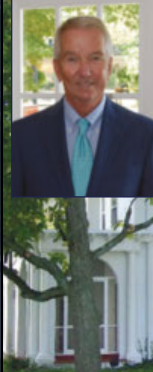
