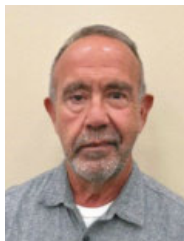

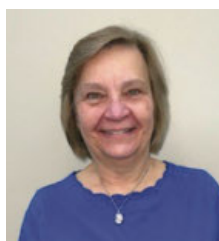


Key Parish Leaders for Target Restructuring Process
