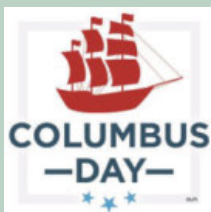

Christmas Card Project

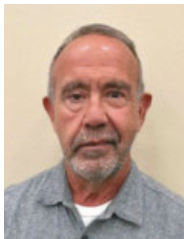

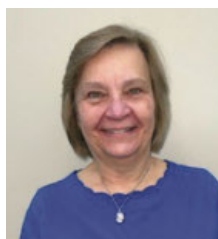

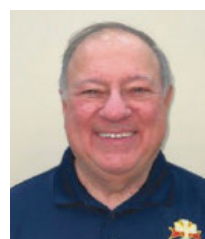
