A message from Fr. Rosenbaum......

It is with great joy and thanksgiving to God that I offer these words today.
WE ARE 100!!! God continues to send blessings upon our parish, He 'Daily Attends Us' is a line from one of our

hymns. And upon being with us daily here at Saint Alexander, we are all blessed to be celebrating 100 years as a parish. It is my humble honor to be in service as pastor with all of my parishioners. The official date for our humble beginnings is October 17, 1924.

We have persevered through the many challenges that parishes can face and have still remained faithful to our call, to our mission out of the love of God in His Son Jesus Christ, by the support of the Holy Spirit for the salvation of souls. As Catholics we are concerned with whole health, in the fullest and truest sense of the phrase, we have to care for body AND soul of every person, because that is the heart of Jesus for humanity.

When I arrived in 2018, it was a difficult time in that I would now have to split my time between two parishes, here at St. Alexander and St. John the Apostle in Villa Park. There was still attrition here from the closing of the school in 2015, which was hard for the parishioners and myself as pastor to experience.

The next big challenge for our parish, and all parishes in our diocese was the global pandemic from COVID-19. For nearly 3 months, from March to June 2020, all of the parishes in our diocese and across the country were closed to the public. Celebrating Masses all by myself was a challenge during that time, especially the Easter Triduum.

Here in 2024, we now face the challenge of restructuring through the diocese for our parish and what 2025 holds for us. But, we at St. Alexander keep making this highest offering of love that our Creator has called us to participation. I am grateful to Bishop Hicks for coming to celebrate our Sunday Mass on October 20. Grateful for the pastors who came before me and all of the priests and deacons. And especially to the parishioners who make St. Alexander such a wonderful and blessed place to be. And all those who have begun and will continue to make our 100th celebrations filled with the joy of the love of God. Ad Multos Annos. (to many more years)

SHROUD OF TURIN




The Knights of Columbus and Fishers of Men will be hosting the **Shroud of Turin Replica Exhibit** at St. Alexander Church October 24—October 28 in the Hall from 9:00am—7:30pm.

The Shroud of Turin is a linen cloth that is believed by many Christians to be the burial cloth of Jesus of Nazareth. The exhibit is a replica of the cloth.

On October 17, 1924, Cardinal Mundelein, of the Archdiocese of Chicago announced the establishment of the parish of Saint Alexander, Pope and Martyr, in Villa Park, and appointed Reverend Henry F. Kennedy pastor.

Did You Know?

In Fr. Kennedy's words—from his scrapbook—"he (meaning the Cardinal) sent me out to dig ditches (for the new parish), and he didn't even give me a shovel!" To provide a structure in which Mass could be said, Fr. Kennedy had Joseph M. Pelnar erect a building—intended as a temporary Church. It was built on property on Cornell Avenue (the site of the present church hall) in just seven weeks, while he continued to celebrate Mass at Meehan's Hall. On December 8, the Feast of the Immaculate Conception, Fr. Kennedy celebrated the 1st Mass in the new temporary Church. Though the building often leaked—Fr. Kennedy called it the "Wooden Ark".




Parishioner Registration




