October is RESPECT LIFE MONTH

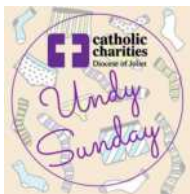

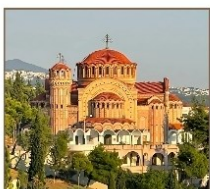

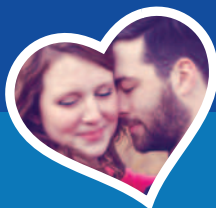
