**A message from Fr. Rosenbaum**

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Praise to you, Lord Jesus Christ, King of endless glory!! I wanted to send out a quick note letting our parishioners know that the property of St. John the Apostle has

been purchased as of March 17, 2026, St. Patrick’s Day, by the community of St. John the Baptist Melkite Church at 200 E. North Ave, in Northlake, IL. The Melkite Church purchased our property at St. John the Apostle for \$1.1 Million, \$800,000 at the signing of the property, and \$300,000, interest-free, over the next 5 years.

The community of St. John the Baptist is very happy to have this new property, and I am happy for them, even though I have many blessed memories of St. John the Apostle and always will. Their property in Northlake has only a parking lot with 40 spaces. If you think finding a parking space is difficult at St. Alexander, just keep in mind the situation of others with less.

The Melkite church came into communion with Rome in the 18th century. They just have different rites, more aligned with Eastern Catholic churches. They have different bishops and different geographical boundaries. The bishop who assisted with the buying of the property is stationed in Boston, for example.

The Catholic Montessori school will remain on the property of St. John the Baptist Melkite church. The pastor is Fr. Imad Barakeh. He is a good-natured priest. I welcomed them to Villa Park, Fr. Imad, and the two parishioners who were with him.

Please keep the St. John the Baptist community in your parishes. Fr. Imad and many of the community members are from various countries in the Middle East area, around Israel, and other countries. Fr. Imad said that his grade school had all its windows destroyed from nearby explosions and that his own parents only made it out of the country two hours before bombs were dropped on their town and were forced to evacuate to Beirut. The media is not reporting this.

Also, the St. John the Baptist community is trying to sell their property in Northlake. We at St. Alexander were blessed to find a buyer, and a Catholic buyer at that, immediately. But they are now responsible for two locations, as we were from July 1, 2025, to March 17, 2026. Taking care of the property and paying the bills at St. John the Apostle was roughly, going to cost us \$55,000 per year. We are now free of that strain on our budget.

So, if you have a moment sometime beginning in May, go over and welcome the St. John the Baptist community to our wonderful village of Villa Park. The boundaries of St. John the Apostle will now remain the boundaries of St. Alexander. Those boundaries were roughly St. Charles Road on the south, Grace St, Lombard on the West, North Ave on the north, and Rt 83 on the East.




