

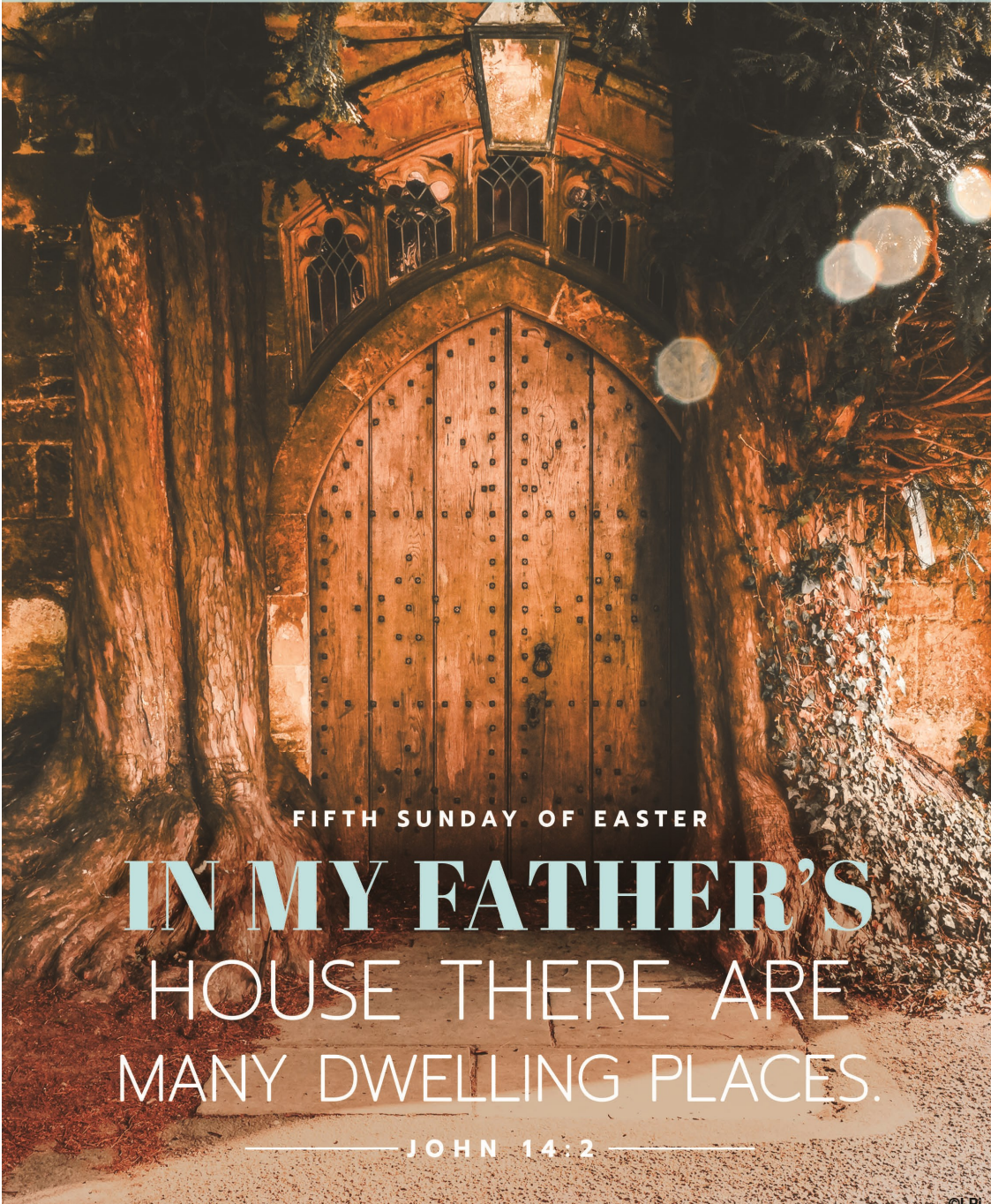

On March 10, severe storms and tornadoes caused widespread destruction in the Kankakee area, damaging homes, vehicles, Bishop McNamara Catholic School, and affecting families throughout our diocese—including those of some of our priests. - **Bishop McNamara Catholic School** - Assistance with repairs to buildings, buses, athletic fields, and other property not covered by insurance.

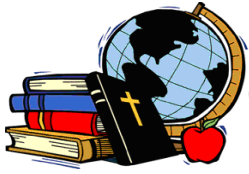

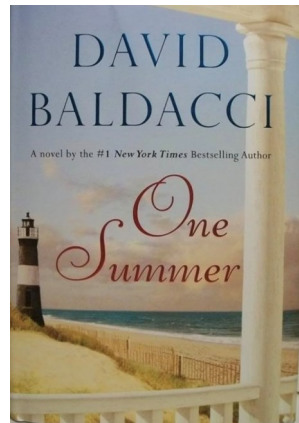

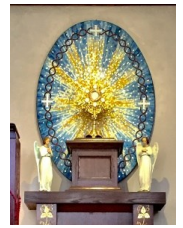
